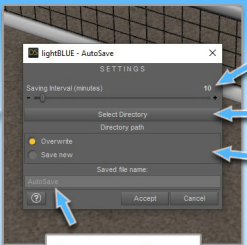




Click on the AutoSave icon

The AutoSave settings window will popup

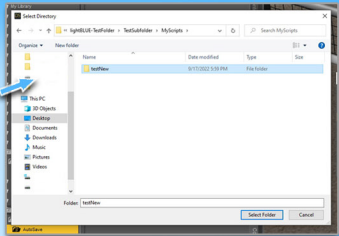


Choose the time interval

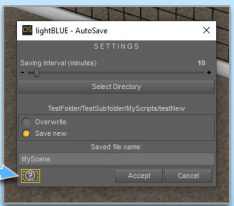
Select where to save your work

Choose one of two saving modes.
Overwrite - to save one file and overwrite it in a given time interval.
Save new - to save a new file each time.

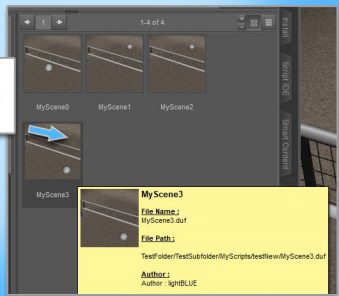
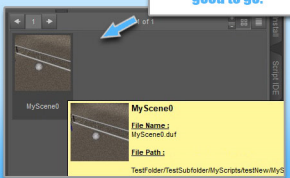
Name your saved scenes. Don't use the same names in the same directory to avoid overwriting the previously saved files. "Save new" mode will add a number at the end.



Click on "What's This" (?) and then on each element in the window to get more information on how to use it.



Click the "Accept" button and you are good to go.

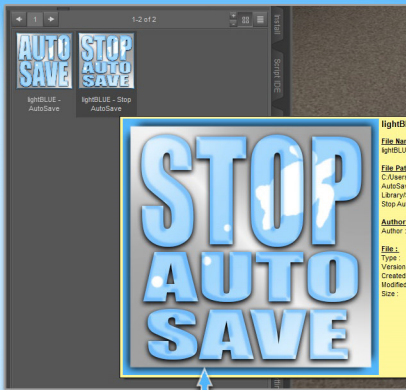
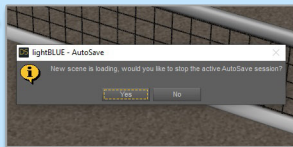
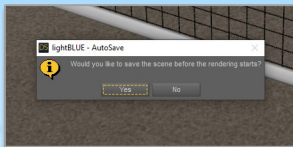

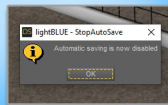




The AutoSave system will remind you to save again just before the rendering starts. It will also warn you in case you start to load a new scene to prevent the overwriting of the previous one.



Stop the saving by clicking on the Stop AutoSave icon. Closing DazStudio will also stop the AutoSave system.
